

Instructions For Selecting Courses Online Using Net Classroom (Ninth Grade Subject Choice Card)

General Instructions

1. Each student must log in using his or her user name and password. A parent's username and password will only allow the parent to view the selected courses.
2. Hover the mouse over the Registration tab and choose Enter Requests.
3. For each course of study, click the arrow and select the appropriate course. If you need to change a selection, select the blank option and begin again.

Academic Courses

1. English – If you are planning to apply for Honors English, select H English 9 in the first blank. In the alternate blank to the right, choose English 9.
2. Math – Choose the appropriate math course. There is no need to select an alternate.
3. Science - If you are planning to apply for Honors science, select H Biology I in the first blank. In the alternate blank to the right, choose Biology I.
4. Social Studies – The ninth grade social studies curriculum is made up of two courses. In the first blank, choose Mississippi History. In the second blank, select World Geography/Cultures. There is no need to select an alternate.

Electives

1. Use blanks 6 and 7 to select your two elective courses.
2. You will only use blank 8 if you choose a semester-length course for one of your electives. If that is the case, remember that you must select two semester-length courses.

When you have finished making all of your selections, click “Submit.”

Notes

- It is helpful to mark a third elective choice on your subject choice card, ***not online***, just in case you are unable to receive your first two elective choices.
- It is not necessary for parents to respond to the school regarding your selections.

- After students have submitted their 2012-13 course selections in Net Classroom, they can edit their selections online as many times as they wish up until the March 6 deadline. Submitting their courses the first time does not “lock in” their course selections. Just be sure to press “Submit” again after making changes.
