ACADEMIC CREDIT PROGRAMS

Each course will last six weeks and offer one academic credit unless otherwise noted.

Dates: June 4 - July 13

Time: 8:15 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.

Fee: \$620 per course

SUMMER SCHOOL PROCEDURES

1. **Jackson Prep policy allows a maximum of four absences in summer school (two in semester courses). These absences may not occur during the last week of the session.** Absentees will be called, and a note is expected following an absence. Since the summer session is considerably shorter than the regular session, absenteeism can cause severe problems. Trips, vacations, etc., should be planned so that they do not conflict with summer school.
2. **No early exams will be given.**
3. A **\$22 textbook fee** has been included in the tuition for all courses except Driver's Education. Textbooks must be turned in after the final exam.
4. Additionally, students enrolled in Advanced Biology must pay a **\$25 lab fee the first day of class.**
5. Dress for summer school is the Jackson Prep school uniform.
6. A concession stand will be open during breaks.
7. Registration and payment for all courses will be at the Jackson Prep Senior High Office.
8. A student who withdraws from summer school the first day will receive a full refund. Those who withdraw after the first day will only receive a partial refund.

Class sizes are limited. Early registration is encouraged.
