- Attend a mentor/mentee breakfast celebration at Prep once a semester at **6:45-8:00 a.m.**
 - Fall semester in the multi-purpose room...**
 - Monday, November 14 for 10th grade girls and mentors
 - Wednesday, November 16 for 10th grade guys and mentors
 - Spring semester in the multi-purpose room...**
 - Thursday, March 22 for 10th grade girls and mentors
 - Friday, March 23 for 10th grade guys and mentors
- Optional: Attend an Extra Mile Mentor Training Workshop (youth culture and mentoring studies)
 - Saturday, October 29 – 8:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. (lunch provided)
 - McRae Center on Prep Campus

11th Grade Year 2012-2013 (total of 3 hours of scheduled activities at Prep in addition to personal contact with your mentee throughout the year at your discretion)

- Attend a one and a half hour mentor/mentee celebration breakfast at Prep once each semester

12th Grade Year 2013-2014 (total of 5.5 hours of scheduled activities at Prep in addition to personal contact with your mentee throughout the year at your discretion)

- Attend a one-and-a-half-hour mentor/mentee celebration at Jackson Prep first semester
- Attend a special Mentor/Student Finale Celebration second semester
- Attend the Graduation of your student mentee in May of 2014
